OUR SERVICES

Companionship

Whether you live across the country or across the street from your ageing family members, it helps to know they have someone nearby if they need support. Sometimes the right home care for your loved one is just having a friendly, compassionate companion who visits regularly to sit, chat, and reminisce.

Personal Care

Our Carers can provide support with personal hygiene and day-to-day routines. We have a wide range of personal care packages designed to help you or your loved one with daily activities in the confines of your home. These packages include washing, helping with pre-poured medicines, incontinence care, personal hygiene, nail care, hair washing, picking out coordinated outfits, and help getting dressed or applying makeup. The Carer will take your best interests at heart.

Home Help Services

It is important that your ageing loved one lives in a clean home so that they enjoy greater feelings of wellbeing and good health. For example, keeping refrigerators and cupboards free of expired or spoiled foods can avert food-borne illnesses. Also, to avoid fire hazards, stoves, toasters, ovens and other appliances must be regularly cleaned to avoid a build-up of grease, oils or crumbs. You & I Care's home help service can literally be a lifesaver as we make it possible for your ageing loved one to enjoy the peace of mind that comes with a clean and uncluttered home while leaving all the work to us.

Palliative Care

Palliative care is an interdisciplinary form of care aimed at improving the quality of life of patients and their families, who are facing problems associated with life-threatening illness. You & I Care provides palliative care as part of a comprehensive supportive care framework defined by the National Institute for Clinical Excellence (NICE), enabling the patient and their family to cope with their condition and treatment of it right from pre-diagnosis, through the process of diagnosis and treatment, to cure, continuing illness or death and into bereavement.

Wake-in Care or Sleep-in Care

Wake-in night care is a form of home care where a Carer remains awake all night to cover any Care needs that might arise, while sleep-in care is a form of home care where a Carer sleeps in your home and is on hand to offer any support when required. Wake-in care is suitable for people with a regular need for support overnight while sleep-in care is suitable for people who don't require regular support overnight. You & I Care provides wake-in and sleep-in care on ongoing basis, or sometimes as a form of respite care which may be required for a short duration.

Live-in Care

You & I Care provides a carefully selected, vetted, and trained Carer to live with you at home. Similarly, we also provide live-in care when a Service User needs temporary support through a period of convalescence or recuperation when returning from hospital. Here, a Carer provides a 24/7 bespoke care service, supporting you to remain independent in the comfort of your own home.

Respite Care

From time to time friends and family might need relief from supporting their loved ones. Respite care is a form of home care that provides short-term relief for primary caregivers. You & I Care's respite care services can give Carers relief from the emotional and physical demands of caring for a friend or family member, and provide an opportunity to participate in community activities. This can be arranged or emergency temporary care can be provided for just a short period of time for example an afternoon or evening, or for several days or weeks.

Dementia Care

Living with dementia can cause increasing care and support needs. This requires a dependable care provider to help with these needs. You & I Care provides dependable home care and support for individuals and families who need this support. By providing dementia care at home, we ensure that our Service Users maintain a familiar and reassuring environment. Our experienced Carers can support Service Users affected by dementia with various daily tasks and we are fully committed to providing support and resources to our Service Users and their families to support them understand this process and access the services they need to continue living the best possible quality of life.
